### **Line of Symmetry**



Another name for reflection symmetry. One half is the reflection of the other half.

The "Line of Symmetry" (shown here in white) is the imaginary line where you could fold the image and have both halves match exactly.

### **Challenge:**

Using the provided graph paper, design a man's breast plate or the pattern on a women's shawl. It must have 2 lines of symmetry and one reflection with 2 elements.




# Image 3... switch roles (Partner A now describes and Partner B has back to the screen)

- 6. Partner B retells the description
- 7. Then image is shown to Partner B
- 8. Partner B gives feedback to Partner A



#### Image 4... Partner A changes partners

- 1. Partner B back to the screen
- 2. Partner A describes the image
- 3. PartnerB does not see the picture but can ask questions and prompts goer
- 4. Stop! Feedback given in middle, and makes connections
- 5. Partner A adds details
- 6. Partner B retells the description
- 7. Then image is shown to Partner B
- 8. Partner B gives feedback to Partner A




